Important Notes:

- 1) A mandatory drivers meeting will be held each morning at 8:45 AM before heading off road. This meeting will be held at The Bear Track Inn to discuss daily activities and safety precautions. All trucks should be fueled prior to the drivers meeting and prepared to leave for the trails at 9:00 AM without having to stop.
- 2) There are no restaurants or rest areas once we depart the main roads. (There are a few outhouses inside Turtle Ridge Off Road Park for the more advanced trail groups.) Be sure to order a box lunch or pack one for both days. You should also have plenty of water to stay hydrated. Please be considerate of your trash as the trails are not club property. Alcohol is not permitted on the trails.
- 3) Cell phone communication is not always guaranteed on the Island therefore every group will be directed to tune in on an individual CB radio frequency. The trip will be much more enjoyable for you, & easier for the trail leaders if every truck has CB communications.
- 4) All groups will generally return to the hotel between 4:30- 5:00 pm.
- 5) Dinner will be at your leisure throughout the event with the exception of the Saturday evening banquet diner.

Please register on-line. As an alternative you may print and fill out the event registration form and return as directed with payment. Mail in registrations must be received on or before July 18th and payment must be included with the registration. NOTE: Registrants must be Hummer Club Inc. members in good standing. Only Hummer vehicles will be allowed on the trail rides and related activities.

Event Fees:

The event fee covers the cost of the reception refreshments, awards banquet dinner, event t-shirts, insurance, and other organizational costs. An event t-shirt will be included for those who register prior to July 16th. Additional shirts *may* be available for purchase at the event.
