Schedule of Activities - Aztec, New Mexico:

Wednesday, September 16th:

4:00 PM to 7:00 PM - Registration and welcome reception will be held at the Step Back Inn, 103 W. Aztec Blvd, Aztec, NM (505) 334-1200. When making your hotel reservation let them know you are with The Hummer Club. A block of rooms for the event are available at \$87 + tax per night with light Continental Breakfast.

Thursday, September 17th thru Saturday, September 19th

A morning drivers meeting will be held each day in the parking lot of the hotel or other designated location. We will then head out to the trail rides and off-road activities in the Aztec and Farmington areas.

Sunday, September 20th:

Caravan or travel at your leisure to Moab. Travel time is approximately 3.5 hours.

Schedule of Activities - Ouray, Colorado:

Friday, September 18th thru Saturday, September 19th

8:30 AM - Meet Dave Breggin at the Best Western Twin Peaks, 125 3rd Ave, Ouray, CO 81427 (970) 325-4427. The off-road trails are in the Ouray area. Note, the Colorado mountain trails are subject to snow closures.

Sunday, September 20th:

Caravan or travel at your leisure to Moab. Travel time is approximately 3 hours.

Schedule of Activities - Moab, Utah:

Sunday, September 20th:

4:00 PM to 5:00 PM – Registration; 5:00 PM to 6:00 PM Open Bar; 6:00 PM welcome dinner will be held at Buck's Grill House located at 13903 N. Highway 191. The Holiday Inn Express will serve as

event headquarters and technical support. The Holiday Inn Express is located at 1515 North Highway 191, Moab, Utah (435) 259-1150. When making your hotel reservation let them know you are with The Hummer Club. A block of rooms for the event are available at \$102 + tax per night with full Buffet Breakfast.

Monday, September 21st thru Wednesday, September 23rd

A morning drivers meeting will be held each day in the parking lot of the hotel or other designated location. We will then head out to the trail rides and off-road activities.

Important Notes:

- 1) You do not have to register in Moab if you attend the first part of the event in Aztec, NM and registered at that time. You "MUST" register in Moab if you attended the Ouray, CO trail rides or are only attending the Moab portion of the event.
- 2) Drivers meeting each morning at 8:45 at all venues will generally be held in the parking lot of the hotel. All trucks should be fueled and prepared to leave for the trails without having to stop.
- 3) Be sure to pack a lunch and plenty of water to stay hydrated.
- 4) Dinner will be at your leisure throughout the event with the exception of the Sunday and Wednesday evening group dinners at Buck's Grill House in Moab.

Activity Descriptions:

Aztec Trails - This year by popular demand we are re-introducing the Aztec/Farmington trails. These trails are difficult and very challenging and are not recommended for first time event drivers. We will run Grim Reaper, Chock Cherry, Rock Garden and Secret.

Ouray Trails - These trails are easy to moderate, very scenic, ascending above 12,000 feet and can be driven by everyone. You will see some World Class mountain views.

Moab Trails - As we do each year, we will run some of the Moab classics, Golden Spike, Moab Rim, Hell's Revenge, and Steel Bender along with a handful of less well known trails. As we've done in

the past we probably won't be running each trail every day and will assign trail groups each morning at our drivers meeting based on your wishes for the day.

A Note About Trail Ratings:

Trail ratings are subjective and should be for general guidance only. Your trail leaders and event coordinators have a great deal of experience leading drivers of all skill levels in all types of Hummer vehicles over these trails. We've take many first time drivers on very difficult trails with excellent results: very little damage and very happy drivers. Regardless of skill level, if a driver listens and follows the trail leader instructions well, he or she should have no problems with any of the trails we are offering.

Easy and/or scenic: Trails will have very few, if any, obstacles and very little risk of mechanical breakage or other truck damage. No spotting should be required on Easy trails.

Moderate: Trails will have quite a few more obstacles than Easy trails, but will still maintain a low likelihood of mechanical problems or truck damage. There may be situations where rocker panel protection contacts obstacles. Some obstacles may require spotting, though this should be minimal.

Difficult: Trails will have many obstacles, some of them quite challenging. There is a moderate likelihood that one or more trucks on the trail will require mechanical attention. Body damage is unlikely, but there will be situations where rocker panel protection contacts obstacles. Trail staff will be spotting participants on all of the difficult obstacles on these trails.

Mechanical Support:

AM General will provide mechanical support for the event in both Aztec and Moab.

Cancellations & Refunds:

We realize that unexpected events such as **work conflicts, mechanical problems and illnesses** may cause you to cancel your event registration. However, we have many business partners that we pay deposits based on a preliminary participant count, therefore in order to limit the impact the following penalties apply to your refund should you choose to cancel:

Prior to August 25th - \$35 penalty
August 25th to September 7th - 50% penalty
After September 7th - 80% penalty
Event date and beyond NO REFUND

Should you choose to transfer from one event to another event in the **SAME** calendar year you may do so for \$35 per transfer.
